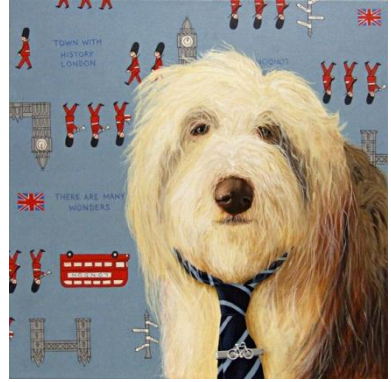

# BEST IN SHOW

Paintings by Paula Zimmermann

Paula Zimmermann was born in Cambridge in 1950, and studied painting, ceramics and Art History at Scarborough University College. Since graduating in 1998, Paula has exhibited widely in Yorkshire, London and Edinburgh and has developed a considerable and loyal following for her idiosyncratic portraits of dogs and their owners.

Heartbreak is delighted to be staging *Best in Show*, Paula's first solo exhibition in London, which features twenty new oil paintings and a range of limited edition prints.

During the exhibition, members of the public will be invited to vote for their favourite dog on-line or in person at the gallery and the winner of the *Best in Show* rosette will be published as a limited edition print, with a percentage of the sales proceeds going to the Dogs' Trust, the UK's largest dog welfare charity. Voters will be entered into a prize draw, with the winner receiving print number 1 out of the new edition.

A special, dog-friendly Private View to launch *Best In Show* takes place at Heartbreak on Thursday 7<sup>th</sup> July, when guests will be encouraged to bring their dogs along to the gallery where water bowls and other treats provided by the Dogs' Trust will be on offer, whilst their owners enjoy the art and vote for their favourite canine candidate.

The winner of the *Best in Show* title, will be announced on Monday 15<sup>th</sup> August and the subsequent limited edition of prints will be available from Heartbreak Publishing from 1<sup>st</sup> October 2011.
